Dear Parent / Carer

Last week it was very sad to hear of the passing of Her Majesty, The Queen, and Rushden Academy joined the nation in paying tribute to Her Majesty. Our thoughts and condolences remain with the Royal Family at this time. May she forever rest in peace.

Following the students' first week back, Monday marked the start of the Academy's comprehensive assembly programme. I delivered an assembly which focused on the question "What makes an effective team?". It was nice to hear from a number of students across all year groups about their personal experiences of being a part of successful teams and then draw parallels between those teams and our very own team, Team Rushden. We discussed our values in depth and looked at other examples of high performing teams such as the Lionesses and the All Blacks rugby team. A key message was about the diversity of teams and how each person plays their own role based on their own unique skills and interests. At the end of the assembly, all students were given time to reflect on their daily contribution to Team Rushden and how that makes this school a great place to be, day in, day out.

You should all be aware that on Tuesday and Wednesday, we welcomed a team of Ofsted inspectors, led by Her Majesty's Inspector, Rakesh Patel, into the Academy. The outcome of this inspection remains confidential and we will inform you of this when we receive the final inspection report. However, can I take the opportunity to thank those of you who took the time to complete the parents' survey. Regardless of the outcome, I was exceptionally proud of the efforts of both staff and students who truly showed what being a part of Team Rushden means during the inspection.

In the midst of the national period of mourning following the sad passing of Her Majesty, The Queen, may I take this opportunity to remind you that Rushden Academy will be closed on Monday the 19th September in accordance with national guidance around the additional bank holiday. Students will return to the Academy as normal on Tuesday 20th September.

How to Access Go4Schools

Go4Schools is the online system that Rushden Academy uses to track student attendance, student progress and assign homework tasks.

Students and parents can access this at home to keep up to date, by checking timetables and homework deadlines. Student progress reports will be published through Go4Schools 3 times a year.

- ◆ Type in your school email address in the first time user box (your computer login in followed by @rushden-academy.net)

Are You Eligible for Free School Meals?

If you are in receipt of any of the following, your child may be eligible for free school meals.

- Income Support
- Income based Job Seekers Allowance
- Income related Employment and Support Allowance
- Support under Part VI of the Immigration and Asylum Act 1999
- Child Tax Credit, with no element of Working Tax Credit, and a household income below £16,190 (as assessed by HM Revenue and Customs)
- Guarantee Element of State Pension Credit
- Universal Credit - income dependant
