What is Fearless.org ?

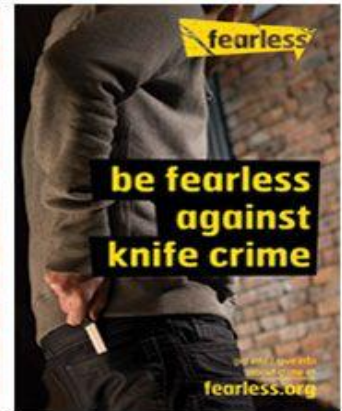
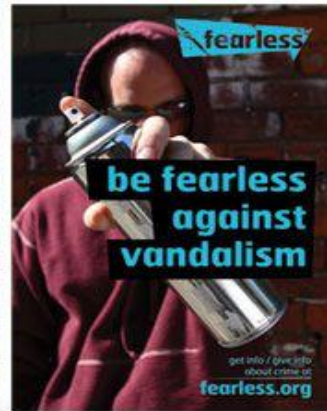
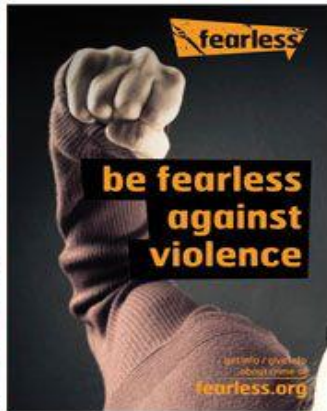
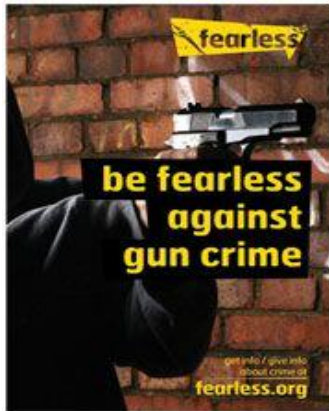
Fearless is the same as Crimestoppers but is just for Young People.

‘Fearless is a website where you can access non-judgmental information and advice about crime and criminality’

‘They also provide you with a safe place to give information about crime - 100% anonymously- you don’t have to provide any personal details, not even your name’

What can I talk to Fearless about?

- You can report any type of crime or something/somebody you might be worried about to Fearless.

Why would I contact Fearless...?

- If you or someone you know are involved in a situation where you feel worried or frightened
- If you feel scared of something/someone
- If you know about something bad that has or might happen
- If you or someone else is at risk of being hurt



How do I contact Fearless?

In the top right hand corner of the
Fearless website you'll see this
button...

CONTACT US ANONYMOUSLY

If you think you or someone else are in danger always call 999

This form is anonymous. No one will know you have sent this info.

If you are using a shared or public computer we encourage you to delete your page history.

Please include as much information as possible as there is no way we can contact you back for more information. If you would prefer to complete the form in a different language please do as we have a translation service available.

If this is urgent, you must **CALL THE POLICE.** We are not a replacement for the emergency services.

What you will see on the screen

THE INCIDENT

* What is the crime or incident you would like to tell us about?

Please let us know what happened and in as much detail as you can remember

* Where did it happen?

Street, town or postcode

* When did it happen?

Pick a date (rough date if not known)

THE PERSON(S) INVOLVED

* What is their name or nickname?

Full name (if known) or any nickname

* What do they look like?

Facial details, hair colour, tattoos etc

Do you know their address?

☐ Yes, I know their address

Do they have access to weapons?

☐ Yes

Do they use Facebook or any other social networking sites?

☐ Yes they do

Do they attend a school/college?

☐ Yes they do

ANONYMITY PROMISE

Our promise of anonymity is important as it is what makes our charity unique.

We guarantee that if you choose to contact us anonymously:

- You can give us information about crime without giving any personal details.
- We will not make note of your gender or age.
- We will not record any personal details you might mention.
- We cannot trace your email or IP address.

We hope that this gives you the confidence to trust our service and remove any fears you might have about telling us what you know about crime.

The only way anybody will know you contacted us, is if you tell somebody.
